

## FAQs

**1. Will we be handling real dead ducks?**

YES. These are real dead ducks. Not fake ones.

**2. Will gloves be provided to handle the ducks?**

YES. Neoprene gloves will be provided; you are welcome to bring your own that don't make your hands sweat as bad.

**3. Do the ducks get reused all day?**

YES. The same ducks are reused for the entire event. The drying station as well as being stored in large fridge trucks are used to maintain the quality of the duck for the entirety of the event.

**4. What should I wear?**

Dress for comfort! Dark clothes or camouflage are preferred so we are not a distraction to the retrievers competing. Wear shoes that are comfortable and ones that you don't mind getting dirty or wet.

**5. Is this a rain or shine event?**

YES. They will have ponchos onsite if needed. It would be a good idea to bring an extra pair of clothing, rain boots or rain gear to help keep yourself dry.

**6. Will volunteers be standing the entire time?**

YES. This is a BYOC (bring your own chair) event! Every job duty will require you to load, place or pick up ducks every 6-9 minutes. If you would like to sit in between you will need to bring your own chair.

**7. What is the minimum age for volunteers?**

This is depending on the maturity of the individual. They see a lot of youth around the age of 13 volunteering their time.

**8. Will food and beverages be provided?**

YES. They will have basic beverages and snacks for all volunteers.

**9. Will we be able to use the restroom during shifts?**

YES. They will have porta potty's at every site and the hunting retriever club will have team members running ATVs between locations all day long and can cover your station if you need to break away for a moment.
